MEET OUR COURSE DIRECTOR

Realizing he was more interested in being underwater than behind a desk, he decided to pack his diving gear and a pair of boardshorts and headed to Thailand.

With 13 years of teaching experience he has trained many students from Open Water Diver to Instructor. As a PADI Course Director, Guillaume has been running the IDCs and other professional courses at Ban's Diving Resort for over 8 years. When he is not training Dive Instructors, he is often seen on the boat ready to jump in with his sidemount set.



To qualify for PADI Instructor Development Course, you'll need to:

- Be certified as a PADI Divemaster or leadership level with another recreational diver training organization.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have been certified as a diver for at least 6 months.
- Be in good physical condition for diving and submit a medical exam form signed by a physician.
- Have completed and logged at least 100 open water dives with experience in night, deep and navigation.

The PADI Instructor Development Course program consists of:

- Formal training in conducting PADI programs and experience programs.
- Independent study assignments.
- Practical application sessions.
- Written examination

Preparation. 2-4 weeks.

The IDC Candidate can arrive 2-4 weeks prior to the IDC start date and participate in Skill practice in Confined Water, Assisting on Courses, Review of Dive Theory, Rescue Skill practice and "fun-diving" to get familiar with the local dive sites around Koh Tao.

Review DM Theory using the Diving Knowledge Workbook, Encyclopedia of Recreational Diving, and Dive Master Exams.

Instructor Development Course. 14 days.

This module includes Assistant Instructor Course, Open Water Scuba Instructor and EFR (CPR and First Aid) Instructor.

This program will build upon your abilities to organize and supervise dive activities, while concentrating on developing teaching skills. Through independent study, classroom sessions and practical application, candidates learn to construct effective teaching presentations and conduct PADI programs. To help you through the program, PADI has developed an array of learning tools.

During the IDC you will use the latest teaching techniques, the complete system of PADI support materials, and will be continuously assessed on your teaching and presentation skills. You will be required to give additional teaching presentations beyond that of the usual IDC Program. This gives you an added advantage not only during the final Instructor Examination (IE), but also prepares you for a future career as a diving professional. Upon successful completion you will be awarded an IDC completion form, which is your passport to the IE.

PADI Instructor Exam. 2 days.

Instructor Examinations is conducted over 2 days with PADI Examiners from PADI Asia Pacific. The I.E. includes evaluation of Dive theory, Standard and Procedures, Academic, Confined and Open Water presentations and Rescue Skill #7 from the PADI Rescue Course.

Diving Instructor Internship Program. 6-8 weeks.

Internship training in one of the most successful dive centres in Asia where you team teach with our Senior Instructors on PADI Courses and Programs to build up experience. At the end of the Internship training most candidates have certified 25-50 PADI Divers. The program is also integrated with Specialty Instructor Training including Enriched Air Instructor, Deep Diver Instructor, Photography Instructor, Wreck Instructor and Night Diving Instructor and more. The internship program ends with an application for Master Scuba Diver Trainer.
